84 Plus CE-T (OS 5.6 or higher)

84 Plus CE-T (Python Edition) (OS 5.6 or higher)

- 1. Turn off your calculator.
- 2. Simultaneously press enter and +, hold these buttons and press on until the following screen appears:



- 3. For ANGLE choose the desired angular measure (you can change this later if you want).
- 4. For STAT DIAGNOSTICS choose ON
- 5. For DISABLE logBASE choose NO
- 6. For DISABLE  $\Sigma$ (: choose NO
- 7. Press zoom (OK)

The calculator will now restart in exam mode. This may take a while.



8. Press any key to activate exam mode.

# Texas Instruments (TI)

Nspire CX (OS 4.5.4 or higher) Nspire CX II-T (OS 5.4 or higher)

- 1. Turn off your calculator.
- 2. Simultaneously press enter and +, hold these buttons and press on until the following screen appears:



- 3. Choose the desired angular measure (you can change this later if you want).
- 4. Choose 'Enter Press-to-Test'.

The calculator will now restart in exam mode. This may take a while.



5. Choose 'OK'.

#### **CASIO**

fx-9860GII (SD) (OS 2.11 or higher) fx-CG50 (OS 3.50 or higher)

- 1. Turn off your calculator.
- 2. Simultaneously press 8 and →, hold these buttons and press AC/ON until the following screen appears:

3. Press F1 (Yes).

How to exit Examination Mode is explained in Link App Continue?:[F2] Stop?:[F6]

4. Press F2 (Continue).



The calculator is now in exam mode.


#### HP

Prime (firmware 2.1.14603 (2021-12-02) or higher)

- 1. Turn on your calculator.
- 2. Simultaneously press On and Esd
- 3. For 'Configuration' choose 'Custom Mode'.



- 4. For 'Timeout' choose '5 Hours'.
- 5. For 'Default Angle' choose the desired angular measure (you can change this later if you want).
- 6. Don't enter a password.
- 7. For 'Memory' choose 'Erase' (if you don't see a dropdown-menu but a checkbox, then mark this checkbox).
- 8. Mark 'Blink LED'.
- 9. Press 'Config' (at the bottom of the screen).



- 10. Mark the following things:
  - User Apps
  - CAS
  - Notes and Programs
  - New Notes and Programs
- 11. Press 'OK' (at the bottom of the screen).
- 12. Press 'Start' (at the bottom of the screen).
- 13. Swipe the icon (the blue lock) to the right to start the exam mode.
